

# Wargrave 5K



TUESDAY 13<sup>th</sup> May 2025 – 7:30pm

## Summary

- Wargrave 5k will be **held at a NEW LOCATION: Hillside in Remenham RG9 3DB /// what3words ///senses.clipboard.whom** (very near last year's location at Temple Island Meadows). There is a **one-way entrance and exit system** in place to minimise the impact on local residents (see map below) which will be clearly signposted on race day. There is ample parking at the event, but not in the surrounding area. The vehicle entry point crosses the race route so will be closed before the start so please arrive in plenty of time.
- Water is available, but no cups will be provided. This is an environmental initiative taken by TVARC.

## Location

The Wargrave 5k will take place at a new location, Hillside in Remenham, at 7:30pm. It is a beautiful location overlooking the valley and river, and should provide us with a truly enjoyable event. The course is entirely on private land with a mix of compacted / loose gravel and grass, and I would describe as undulating.

## Directions

Competitors are encouraged to access the event with minimal car usage (lift-sharing, train, bike etc.). It is a level 1.5 mile (~2.5K) walk/cycle from the centre of Henley, which is served by Arriva 800/850 or the GWR branch line from Twyford.

Please aim to arrive between 18:05 and 19:00.

- NB: access to race site will close around 19:15 for safe running of the race.
- The venue is **at Hillside, Remenham Church Lane, Remenham, Henley on Thames, RG9 3DB / what3words ///senses.clipboard.whom**.
- There is a **one-way entrance and exit system** in place to minimise the impact on local residents (see map below), which will be clearly signposted on race day. Please **approach the race via Remenham Church Lane**, off the A4130, signposted "Remenham Church" **what3words ///crumbles.treble.presenter** (halfway between Henley Bridge and the Shell garage).
- Once race site access is closed, there is no overflow parking provision. Please do not park on the road where you may inconvenience local residents.
- Exit access from the site will be opened once final runners have cleared that part of the course, which we expect to be soon after 20:00
- Traffic leaving the event should turn left, along Remenham Lane, past The Little Angel Pub, back onto the A4130.

Note that the roads for the last couple of kilometres to the venue are narrow country lanes so to avoid traffic congestion we request that you follow the above route in which is via Remenham Church Lane off the A4130 and **NOT** from the turning at The Little Angel Pub turning or from Aston. Both these roads are very narrow with few passing places.

**From Henley:** Travel along the A4130 up Remenham Hill for just over half a mile. Please DO NOT turn left

at The Little Angel Pub. Turn left at Remenham Church Lane, signposted “Remenham Church”, and follow it almost to the bottom where you will be directed right towards the site.

**From Hurley:** If you approach from Hurley, please DO NOT turn right towards Aston Village. Please continue a further half a mile and then turn right down Remenham Church Lane, signposted “Remenham Church”. Follow Remenham Church Lane almost to the bottom where you will be directed right towards the site.

### **Parking**

There is plenty of parking available on the field at the event site. However, as access to the site crosses the race route, it will not be possible to enter or exit the site just before the start and for approximately 30 minutes after the start.

### **Race Route**

The race will be run on compacted / loose gravel and grass tracks on private land. The course is **UNDULATING** and consists of 2 laps.

### **Cups**

A reminder to bring your own cup or water bottle to the race as no plastic cups will be provided.

### **Children**

Children aged 12 and over are allowed to run this event. Although run on private land vehicle access crosses a small part of the course which will be closed to vehicles for the main duration of the race. Parents of children must accept that by allowing their children to run, they run at their own risk and are happy their children can make decisions in order to keep themselves safe. The race, while marshalled, is not supervised by club coaches.

### **Charity Donation**

As a condition of using their site, Copas Estates have asked that we ask for voluntary donations in lieu of charging for parking. There will be buckets available to collect cash on arrival. Last year we raised £250 on the day, and added the profits from the race, totalling a donation of £300.

### **Wargrave 10k & Kids Fun Run**
